Helping victims of child abuse is more than a desire, it is our lifetime commitment. This commitment began in 1959, when our founders, Sara O'Meara and Yvonne Fedderson, then two young Hollywood actresses on a USO tour, encountered 11 homeless orphans, and all of their lives were forever changed.

With help from servicemen and friends, the two provided for those children, and their work expanded into South Vietnam, building and supplying five orphanages, a hospital and a school. With the eventual drawdown of US troops there, came uncertain futures for the children. In 1975, they helped organize "Operation Babylift" to extract thousands of threatened South Vietnamese Amerasian children for adoption in the US.

Once stateside, a request from Nancy Reagan prompted Sara and Yvonne to use their influence to address 'America's best kept secret' — child abuse. In 1978, the organization opened Children's Village USA (now Childhelp Merv Griffin Village). A few years later, the lines opened at 1 800 4 A CHILD, the first and only national hotline devoted to child abuse issues, and the organization would influence Presidents Carter and Reagan to observe National Child Abuse Awareness Month, now every April.

With facilities in California, Virginia, Tennessee, Arizona and the District of Columbia, and programs and services impacting every state, Childhelp has already reached more than ten million children, and looks to meet the physical, emotional, educational and spiritual needs of abused, neglected and at-risk children well into the future.

Our Solution.

Through treatment programs like Childhelp Advocacy Centers, the National Child Abuse Hotline (1-800) 4-A-Child and Childhelp Group Homes that are designed to help children already affected by child abuse, and prevention programs like Childhelp Speak Up Be Safe, designed to educate children and aid in prevention, we can help change the lives of many.

Our Impact.

The Orange County Chapter has been supporting Childhelp and its California programs, including three Group Homes in Costa Mesa and the Childhelp Merv Griffin Village in Beaumont, since 1970. Members have had a tremendous impact on the lives of abused and neglected children through the successful Childhelp Treatment Programs.
