He returned to his alma mater, coaching the USD mock trial team to a national championship, and taught trial practice skills at USD School of Law for 15 years. He served as President of the Consumer Attorneys of San Diego, holds membership as an Associate in the prestigious American Board of Trial Advocates, and was a Master in the Louis B. Welsh Inn of Court.

In 2015 Hulburt developed a part-time mediation practice at West Coast Resolution Group. His unique combination of courtroom trial skills and mastery of the mediation process made him much in-demand among lawyers on both sides for his thoughtful listening, ability to name and hold the emotions behind the story, and keen insight to forge creative solutions.

Hulburt and his wife live in Pacific Beach. They have four adult children, and five grandchildren.
