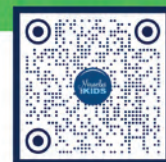

ABOUT THE EVENT

THE IMPACT

Harvesters 2020 fundraising campaign and virtual event netted more than \$1.6 million to help Second Harvest's efforts to feed the hungry in OC. The funds will have a significant impact, helping us provide food to those in need through our partner network which includes pantries at schools, colleges and houses of worship, after school programs, senior centers, homeless shelters, and transitional housing facilities.

THE NEED

In Orange County, pandemic-related unemployment has been devastating for tens of thousands of newly vulnerable families, as well as those who traditionally seek our help – the working poor, seniors on fixed incomes, veterans, people with disabilities, and the homeless. From March through December 2020 we provided more than 50 million pounds of food for those in need of supplemental food assistance.

In Orange County, **one in six children** face food insecurity.

Our at-risk community includes:

- More than 500,000 food-insecure people – double last year's number due to the economic fallout of COVID-19
- Seniors on a fixed income, more than 45% of whom can't afford basic necessities

THE GOAL

Second Harvest Food Bank and its partners work tirelessly to provide nutritious, healthy food for those in need. We continue to implement innovative solutions to eliminate the root causes of hunger, creating a community where all our children have the nutrition they need to be healthy, to learn, and to succeed.
